## Identification



NO PHOTO IDENTIFICATION | NO ENTRY | NO EXCEPTIONS



All persons wishing to enter LPC must present identification

- A valid driver's licence
- A valid passport

LPC provides photo identification and access cards for applicants who are regular users of the port. For an application form please visit the LPC Security Control Centre or link to our website [www.lpc.co.nz](http://www.lpc.co.nz).

## Visitors



All persons entering LPC must wear Hi vis and closed in footwear as a minimum and must comply with all legislation and regulations:

- Maritime Security, Customs, MPI regulations
- Health and Safety in Employment Act 1992 NZ
- Visitors to ships must have the authority of the Ship's Master or agent
- Electronic equipment, cigarettes, lighters or matches are prohibited in hazardous goods areas and on the LPC Oil Wharf.

## Vehicle Access



- All vehicles entering port operations may be subject to random searching
- Please observe the road rules for the safety and convenience of all vehicle operators
- Vehicles entering restricted zones must proceed with caution
- A roof flashing light must be used when parking adjacent to a vessel
- Park in designated parking areas where provided

## Crew Bus



Dial +64 3 328 7917 for a Shuttle Bus to the Gate

This is a FREE service – **NO PEDESTRIAN ACCESS** is permitted on Cashin Quay.

The Shuttle can be contacted through Security on 328 7917 in the first instance. If people do not have access to a telephone, then the Shuttle can be called on VHF Channel 12.

## Access Gates



Exit the gate nearest your location to avoid transiting through the port.

- Container Terminal
- Cashin Quay (CQ)
