COVID-19 BORDER RESPONSE

As you will be aware, we remain at COVID-19 Alert Level 2 until at least Sunday September 6, 2020.

We would like to thank all customers, shipping agents, transporters and Port users for their support of Lyttelton Port Company as we continue to navigate this everchanging environment.

We continue to work closely with the Ministry of Health, Canterbury District Health Board, Ministry of Transport, Customs and other New Zealand Ports to ensure we are supporting the Government's border response to COVID-19.

As part of this, Customs has notified LPC that from August 28, Customs personnel currently stationed at LPC will be joined by New Zealand Defence Force staff, and from September 8 Department of Conservation staff.

These staff have received Customs training and will be designated as an enforcement officer under the Maritime border Order. They have also been tested for Covid-19 prior to deployment. They will be buddied with an experienced Customs Officer and will work with our security team.

This is part of the Government's wider border response to COVID-19, and our people continue to support Customs in their work here at LPC.
