### **COVID-19 BORDER RESPONSE**

As you will be aware, New Zealand remains at COVID-19 Alert Level 1. We would like to thank all customers, shipping agents, transporters and Port users for their support of Lyttelton Port Company as we continue to navigate this everchanging environment.

We continue to work closely with the Ministry of Health, Canterbury District Health Board, Ministry of Transport, Customs and other New Zealand Ports to ensure we are supporting the Government's border response to COVID-19.

As part of this, an updated Ministry of Health Order was issued in September that makes COVID-19 (nasal swab) testing of certain categories of LPC workers and certain Port users compulsory every 14 days. This is being carried out by the Canterbury District Health Board (CDHB) and Pegasus Health onsite.
