LPC Main Gate swipe out trial

In preparation for work to begin swipe-out for all vehicles at the main exit gate, we are running a swipe-out trial on Tuesday April 27.

What is happening?

From 1400 hours to 1700 hours, the main exit gate will not automatically open. Prior to exiting the Port via the main gate (site map below) vehicles will need to stop 6 meters in front of the gate. LPC staff will be visible and available to manage this trial.



How this could impact you:

During this trial the main gate will not automatically open as it does today.

You will need to be aware that vehicles in front of you will be stopping at the main gate before exit.

Follow the road code and do not cross the rail track unless there is space for your vehicle on the other side.

Keeping everyone at LPC safe

This work is being carried out as part of a Port Presence project to update the software and gate systems at LPC. We are working to implement an effective swipe-in/swipe-out process so we can manage safety and security across all LPC sites.

Importantly, this work is to ensure we know who is on site at all times, adhering to our legal obligations under both the Health and Safety at Work Act and Maritime Security Act.

Further gates will be upgraded in the coming months and we will keep you updated.
