## Community Update

### *Rio de Janeiro* at LPC

The *Rio de Janeiro* container vessel will be berthed at Lyttelton and operational from the early hours of Tuesday May 4 to the early hours of Thursday May 6.

The Rio's have four generators for onboard power, one of which is fitted with a reactive silencer which effectively reduces low frequency noise. When alongside at the berth the ship is required to use only the silenced generator.

LPC has been notified by the ship's master that at some point during their operation, the vessel will have to use a second on board generator due to the significant number of refrigerated containers being loaded.

This large exchange of containers is due to the ongoing delays and congestion in the global supply chain.

The ship's master has said they will do everything they can to minimise the noise, and LPC will be working closely with the vessel to minimise the period they use the additional generator.

We understand this may be frustrating for you and would like to apologise in advance.

We know that keeping our noise levels at a minimum is important to the communities that we are part of, and we will keep you updated on further developments.
