COVID-19 Update: moving to the traffic light system

New Zealand has now entered the traffic light system, with Christchurch currently in orange.

For LPC, the change in COVID-19 frameworks has minimal impact on our ways of working as we continue our safety measures which includes increased hygiene, PPE, physical distancing, and a regular testing regime.

The health and safety of our staff, port users and the community remain our top priority and that's why we recently announced that all LPC employees need to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19. This decision was made following a risk assessment of our operations and we believe this is an important step in preventing the spread of the virus.

We have also announced that from January 31, 2022, all port users will also need to be fully vaccinated to enter any LPC site. This includes service providers, stevedores, provedores, contractors, truck drivers, delivery drivers, distributors, and all other port users.

LPC remains a crucial link in the supply chain for New Zealand and a support for the Canterbury economy and these vaccine requirements help to ensure we can continue to operate in the new COVID-19 environment.
