2. You must have a valid charge account with LPC
3. The container/s listed below must have been pre-advised at the time of applying

IMPORTANT NOTES: Applications are processed by the Customer Services Unit daily – applications received **after 4pm** may be processed the following day. Application approvals are subject to availability of yard space in the Container Terminal and the Terminal may restrict the total number of containers accepted for Early Receipt. The gate-in date approved may differ from that requested and applications may be declined immediately if the requirements outlined above have not been met in full. Containers arriving outside the Cargo Acceptance period without LPC approval will not be gated-in. Any costs quoted are based on vessel ETA at the time of application so are subject to change. A change of vessel, port of discharge, CEDO or any other booking/pre-advised detail after gate-in will incur additional fees. Costs incurred will be billed to the Applicant and not to a 3rd party. Early receipt is not available for Hazardous Cargo (DGs).
