

## Request for Engine Immobilisation at the Port of Lyttelton

## Vessels to note that LPC permits engine immobilisation under following conditions -

- Request for immobilisation must be sent to Lyttelton pilots minimum 24 hours prior to planned immobilisation. Please send completed form to <a href="mailto:pilot@lpc.co.nz">pilot@lpc.co.nz</a>
- Immobilisation of main engine will not be permitted if wind gust forecast is >30 knots at any time during the immobilisation period.
- LPC does not permit engine immobilisation on public holidays including 12 hours before and after the public holiday.
- Approvals will be given for a maximum of 24 hrs for each request.
- Vessel must inform Harbour radio via radio CH12 before immobilisation commences and again when completed.

• The ship's lines are to be properly tended at all times, and if required, extra mooring lines are to be put out.
