



Lyttelton Climbs 112 Spots in Global Port Ranking

Lyttelton climbs 112 spots in global ranking; Achieves 33.6% efficiency boost

Lyttelton has achieved a significant boost in our operational efficiency, reducing ship turnaround times.

In 2024, LPC recorded one of the largest year-on-year improvements globally in the World Bank Report.

LPC's global ranking (CPPI) has risen from 385th to 273rd out of 403 ports worldwide.

Average vessel turnaround time at Lyttelton has dropped from 52.7 hours in 2023 to 34.8 hours in 2024, a 33.6% decrease.

This turnaround time metric is a crucial indicator of port performance and a global benchmark, affecting berth availability, shipping confidence, and overall terminal throughput.

Enhanced berth planning, real-time decision-making, strong collaboration with shipping lines, and operational resilience have all contributed to delivering robust turnaround time performance.

Our priorities for FY26 will focus on further integrating digital systems across LPC to improve capability, continuing to invest in safe and efficient work practices, and embedding a performance culture through coaching and shared KPI's.
